Info-byte: Providing Access to Digital Records

What will be produced to researchers?

There are several different "versions" of the records systems that can be produced for the researchers. The alternatives are:

- Provision of a copy of the whole data file to the researcher
- Provision of an extract of the data
- Provision of a data analysis

How will the provision be delivered?

Provision can be delivered in many different ways:

- > The archives can provide direct access in the reading room
- The archives can contract a computer services firm to deliver access
- > The researcher can be provided with a copy of the record and left to make their own arrangements for hardware and systems provision
- Access can be provided via the internet
